## How Do I Help?

I provide a 32 week program that paces nationally-accredited curriculum with online Zoom “classroom” sessions held 2 days a week. I provide enrichment, students work together on some assignments in the Zoom breakout rooms, and can work with a student 1:1 if needed at times.

The 32 week classroom is divided into 8-\$150 monthly payments. There is also a semester material fee of \$100.
